

Launching a Personal Devotion Group

Now that you are doing your daily personal devotions, are you ready to go to the next level in your relationship with God? Here's how: Personal Devotion Groups, or as we like to call them: **"Devo Groups."** Simply put, Devo Groups are 2-3 people who gather weekly to share what God has shown them in their time of personal devotion.

Throughout the New Testament, we can see what happens when Believers gather around the Word and Prayer. (Acts 2, 4; Matthew 18:20) **Now, it's your turn: Launch a Devo Group.**

Find a few friends and meet weekly to share what God has been showing you during your SOAP devotions and pray for each other.

Examples for Devo Groups:

- You can sit and discuss the Scriptures over coffee
- Talk about your SOAP observations at the gym
- Talk about it before you go for a run or a surf with your friends
- Before or after class
- Over lunch
- On a playdate
- Meet up on Facebook and comment back and forth about the Chapter of the Day

You will be amazed at how this simple habit of meeting regularly will supercharge your relationship with God, and keep you growing in Christ.

How do I start my Devo Group?

Step 1: do your daily devo (Use the Celebration Reading Plan and SOAP method of journaling)

Step 2: grab your friends and meet

Step 3: register your group on the Devo Groups webpage on celebration.org/resources

It's that simple. **Enjoy your daily time with God. Share it with others. Pray. Repeat.**
